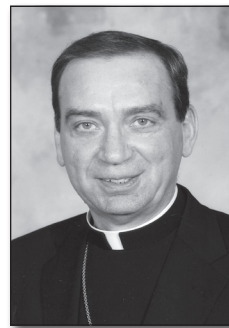

Board members are appointed for a three-year term. They serve no more than two consecutive three-year terms. The standing committees are Nominating, Agency Advancement, Service Policy, Personnel Practices, and Finance. Board members are asked to assist, promote and support various events and fundraisers held by the agency. The board meets six times annually, bi-monthly starting in February. They receive financial updates and reports at each meeting.



## CINCINNATI SERVICE CENTER

### **PARENTING AND COMMUNITY EDUCATION**

- Provided parish and community based classes for over 900 people parents in a variety of formats as well as providing consultations to local agencies and organizations.

### **GIFTS OF THE MAGI**

- A total \$55,489 was collected in the calendar year from Jan to Dec 2009.

### **MENTAL HEALTH COUNSELING**

- A total of 4,223 sessions were held in 2009, serving 701 clients, including a total of 382 new clients admitted;
- With the hiring of our bilingual therapist in September of 2009, 24 Spanish-speaking clients were served between September and December of 2009.
- Of the 701 total clients served, 547 (78%) of these clients were economically disadvantaged.
- Of the 701 total clients served, 88 (13%) of clients served were under the age of 18.
- Of 349 new clients responding to a satisfaction survey, 338 (97%) reported at the end of the first session that they felt respected and understood by their counselor.
- Of 382 clients initiating counseling, 338 (88%) reported at the end of the first session that they felt respected and understood by their counselor
- Of 382 clients initiating counseling, 274 (72%) participated in the development of an individualized treatment plan by the third session.
- Of 174 clients remaining in treatment for at least six sessions, 74 (43%) reported a significant reduction in symptoms by the sixth session.
- Of 114 clients who reported impaired coping skills at the beginning of treatment, 83 (73%) reported improved coping skills by the sixth session

### **POSTPONING SEXUAL INVOLVEMENT**

- Postponing Sexual Involvement (PSI) was presented at 24 Catholic elementary schools, high schools, and religious education programs reaching 1,594 young people. PSI also served inmates from the Hamilton County Youth Detention Center and residents from the Living Hope Transitional Home. In addition, 967 11th and 12th grade students participated in the Bi-annual Junior/Senior Survey. 23 volunteer teen peer presenters from local Catholic high schools assisted in the presentations at 100% of scheduled schools, volunteering 162 hours.
- Overall, over 97% of the students found the program helpful to some degree.
- 94% of students stated that “setting limits” is important in controlling sexual activity.
- 100% of the parents attending the Parent Information Night rated the program helpful in some degree.
- 92 % of parents believed the issues covered by the PSI program are relative to the challenges their child will encounter.
- Measuring long-term outcomes, 88% of 11th and 12th grade students surveyed on the Bi-annual Survey stated they believe there are benefits to postponing sex until marriage.

### **REFUGEE RESETTLEMENT**

- Assisted 63 families and 141 total refugees from five different countries.
- Provided housing for 48 families, improved housing for 37 families arriving in previous years and retained housing for 39.
- Developed employment plans for 135 people; Provided job readiness training for 100; obtained employment at a living wage for 41 of 51 or 80%; and from the previous year 23 of 41 or 56% retained or improved their employment.

### **CAREGIVER ASSISTANCE NETWORK**

- The programs served 2,450 caregivers living in the Southwestern Ohio region;
- 87 volunteers provided 6,223 hours of volunteer service to the program.

### **ADOPTION**

- The Adoption Program completed 9 adoptions, including:
  - 2 Domestic infants
  - 4 children with special needs and
  - 3 International placements
- A total of 253 clients were served in our Post Adoption Services.

### **SENIOR CORPS PROGRAMS**

- 94 volunteers in the Foster Grandparents Program provided a staggering total of over 86,160 hours of service to an estimated 1200 children in the Greater Cincinnati area.
- 91 volunteers in the Senior Companions Program provided a total of over 67,697 hours of service to an estimated 250 seniors in the Greater Cincinnati area.
- 401 RSVP volunteers served 37,520 hours at 31 non-profit organizations and health care facilities.

### **SU CASA HISPANIC CENTER**

- Provided services and programs to 1,984 clients.
- Offered 7 different levels of ESL classes.
- Offered the Summer Program “Vacaciones Utiles”. There were 40 students enrolled in the program

### **NBSC**

- The Northern Brown Senior Center provided activities and services to 152 senior citizens living in Brown County.

### **HOME CARE**

- 81 of 87 (95%) care receivers and their caregivers learned about risk factors.
- 39 of 50 (78%) care receivers identified personal care or homemaking limitations affecting their chronic conditions.
- 39 of 50 (78%) of care receivers report that they are receiving the services they need after six months.
- 81 of 87 (93%) identify limitations in their personal care or home care abilities within 90 days
- 08 of 114 (95%) care receivers report that they are receiving the help they need to live at home after 1 year

## A Message from the Executive Director

Dear Friends,

Several weeks ago I was part of the celebration of the 100th Anniversary of the founding of Catholic Charities USA. On the actual date of our founding, September 25th, representatives of Catholic Charities USA gathered at the National Shrine of the Immaculate Conception in Washington, DC for a Mass of Thanksgiving and rededication. I thought of the four hundred men and women who gathered at Catholic University on September 25, 1910 and made their commitment to establish a national organization. The group was comprised of priests, religious men and women and laypersons, all involved in responding to the needs of the poor and vulnerable in their own dioceses. They were united in their desire to provide quality social services and to fulfill their own baptismal call of service and love of neighbor. Faced with the challenges of waves of immigrants, uneducated and often unwelcome in this country because of religion, those gathered in Washington understood that there needed to be an organized and coordinated response to their plight.


Three and a half years after that initial gathering, a Catholic Charities agency was established in Cincinnati with the same vision, the same goals and the same commitment. When I think back on the past 100 years, I am proud of the many accomplishments of Catholic Charities at both the national and the local level. I am also humbled by the sacrifices made by the staff members, and the volunteers who have come before us and who dedicated their lives to the work of helping those in need. I think about the many challenges facing the agency – all of the immigrants who came to our communities seeking a

better life, people facing war and coping with the loss of loved ones, the challenges of the Great Depression and all the other economic upheavals we have endured, increasing urbanization, job changes and job losses, changes in family life, poverty. Again and again I am reminded of our core beliefs, we work with people; we help them to help themselves; in our services we provide help and most importantly we create hope.

As we begin another century of service I am reminded of what has sustained us in the past and what will continue to sustain us in the future. I think this is best articulated in the words of the Catholic Charities USA Vision Statement: “Believing in the presence of God in our midst, we proclaim the sanctity of human life, and the dignity of the person, by sharing in the mission of Jesus given to the Church. To this end Catholic Charities works with individuals, families and communities to help them meet their needs, address their issues, eliminate oppression and build a just and compassionate society.”

Thank you for helping us to be a part of this glorious tradition.

## Catholic Charities SouthWestern Ohio 2009 AGENCY *Success Stories*



### HAMILTON SERVICE CENTER

- 81% of all individuals served in agency programming fell below the federal poverty guidelines.
  - **Partnerships:** the HSC continues long term relationships with Butler County Children Services, Butler County Juvenile Court and in 2009 expanded or developed new partnerships with the Butler County Mental Health Board, Miami University and Supports to Encourage Low Income Families (SELF). New and sustaining funding from ODMH and the Ohio Children’s Trust Fund have allowed us to expand mental health services to young children and provide training to their parents and caregivers (preschools and daycare providers). This has increased Catholic Charities involvement with school districts throughout Butler County.
  - Overall **Consumer Satisfaction Questionnaire** results for 2009 reveal that: 92% of respondents reported “excellent” service; 90% received the help they needed; 97% would refer a friend; 95% would return

### SPRINGFIELD SERVICE CENTER

- The Second Harvest Food Bank of Clark, Champaign and Logan Counties distributed 3,330,348 pounds of food serving 337,111 clients through its 105 member agencies. This included our Commodity Supplemental Food Program serving 14,587 food boxes to over 1,375 income eligible seniors.
- The Catholic Charities Emergency Assistance program helped 29,165 clients. This included 18,556 clients served at the Catholic Charities Emergency Pantries in all three counties and 10,609 clients received cash assistance with rent and utilities. This represents a 75% increase over 2008. Part of the increase was due to the addition of stimulus pass thru funding.
- The Work Experience Program met its demise at the end of 2009. Severely reduced funding at the county level resulted in major programmatic grant reductions and cancellations. This program was one of them. Annually we served 3,617 food stamp recipients, placing them on work sites to compensate for their benefits.
- The Mental Health Counseling program served 182 clients, 132 of which were new, in 2009, seeing additions of the Developmental Disabled population and significant increases in PASSPORT in home services for seniors.
